The burner is coupled to your standard high pressure cleaner, quickly converting your cold water machine to a hot water unit. The advantages of the separate boiler system is the ability to use the unit on various machines as and when you need hot water. Also if the boiler requires service you can still operate with your cold water unit thereby reducing down time. The units operates on a 220 volt power supply and can handle volumes of up to 15 l/min and pressures up to 200 bar. The unit retails for R 7500.00 +VAT.

The ZVX pumps are submersible vortex pumps designed for lifting dirty water which is not chemically aggressive.
