## Year in Focus

Each month since the first issue of Clean 'n Coat News in March last year we have used this section to focus in on a particular product. This month we will be taking look back at these products.

### Issue 1 - March 1999 - The 211 Roadmarking Unit

The 211 roadmarker has gone through some changes since we first did a focus on it in March. A new three wheel chassis has been used making the unit far more compact. The price was also reduced from R22,500.00 to an economical R17,500.00. The unit is perfect for marking roads, sports fields, garages, schools, parking lots and factories.




### Issue 6 - August 1999 - Humidifying and Cooling in Poultry Houses

Spraying Systems Co. is now producing nozzles that give ultra fine droplets, at relatively low pressure (up to 14 bar). The small drop size will remain in the air longer, allowing complete evaporation, for more efficient cooling.



### Issue 2 - April 1999 - Roty 18 Tank and Drum Cleaning Nozzle

The Roty 18 is a rotating nozzle designed as an attachment for your high pressure cleaner. It is particularly suitable for cleaning medium and small drums and tanks at high pressure. The unit handle pressures up to 150 bar and volumes up to 18l/min.




### Issue 7 - September 1999 - Hydra-Cell, Industrial Pumping Solutions


### Issue 3 - May 1999 - Stainless Steel Safety Showers

### Issue 5 - July 1999 - Whirl-A-Way Roof and Surface Cleaner

The unit consists of two rotating flat or solid stream nozzles attached to two arms that rotate at very high speed to cover the entire area under the protective cover.



### Issue 10 - December 1999 - High Pressure Nozzles
