The New Improved VBXL Unloader Valve

The Hawk VBXL unloader valve has recently been improved. In conjunction with the factory in Italy, Monitor was instrumental in bringing about the new improvements, making the valve even more reliable.

The VBXL is designed for larger high pressure systems and is capable of pressures of up to 210 bar and high volumes up to 50 l/min. It is used on all the larger standard Hawk units.

All the money that is received by the licensing department, goes toward upgrading rural roads. So far, there has been about R6,000,000 collected in this way.


