Year in Focus

Each month since the first issue of Clean 'n Coat News in March 1999, we have used this section to focus in on a particular product. This month we will be taking look back at these products.

Issue 12 - February 2000 - Zero Pressure Regulator

The Zero Pressure Regulator works on a "demand" principle of operation. This regulator is normally in a closed position. When the pump is turned on, a vacuum is produced in the suction line. This vacuum acts on the diaphragm which opens the regulator allowing water to enter the pump. The vacuum is always constant.



Issue 13 - New 500 bar Spaggiari Piston Pump

Spaggiari has released an upgraded version of their EC Series pumps. The new ECH Series includes models capable of 64L/min at 180 bar, to 26L/min at 500 bar. These pumps are manufactured in Italy, to the highest standards.



Issue 14 - April 2000 - Chemical Supply Unit

The new chemical supply unit has recently been designed to make the transportation and application of chemical easier. The system was designed to work with a high pressure cleaner. The unit is made up of a live hose reel, foaming lance and chemical injection system.



Issue 15 - May 2000 - Hands Free Whirl-A-Way Roof Cleaner

A new model has been added to the Whirl-A-Way range of rotating roof cleaning accessories. These units are used in conjunction with a high pressure cleaner, to clean large areas quickly. This unit is ideal for pitched roofs. It can be lowered down the slope by the hose, allowing the operator to work from the ridge, making use less dangerous.



Issue 16 - June 2000 - The Black Hawk Unit

A new direct mount Black Hawk high pressure cleaning unit is now available. The unit couples the pump directly to the motor without the need for a bell housing and coupler. Models are available in a 15L/ min 200 bar versions. The new seals have a substantially longer life.



Issue 17 - July 2000 - The Hawk Hot Box

An exciting new design has been used for the locally manufactured high pressure water heater. It is made of high grade stainless steel. Connected to a normal cold water unit, the hot box provides high pressure hot water to remove heavy grease and dirt. (Version now up to



Issue 18 - August 2000 - The Hose Tote

The new hose tote is now mounted onto a trolley so that it can be moved around easily. It is made of high grade stainless steel, designed to carry 10-30m of high pressure hose, and can handle pressures of 200 bar. It is a live hose reel, so the hose can be retracted while the system is in operation. (Versions up to 100m)



Issue 19 - September 2000 - The New Hand Held Whirl-A-Way

The new mini Whirl-A-Way works on the same principal as the large floor and roof cleaning machines, but it is small enough to be hand held. Because of its size, it can be used for cleaning small areas, like removing graffiti from walls.



Issue 20 - October 2000 - Flojet Vibrating Pump

The new Flojet vibrating pumps are designed for general consumer, commercial and industrial applications. These pumps are constructed to deliver 90,8L/Hr and at pressures of up to 60psi (4.1 bar), and are capable of handling a broad range of liquids.



Issue 21 - November 2000 - Sirai Solenoid Valves

The Sirai Solenoid Valves come in a variety of shapes and sizes for air, water and chemicals, the largest of which being 2" (50mm). The valves are available in 2-, or 3-way, normally open or normally closed, direct acting or pilot operated, voltages can be AC or DC 12V, 24V, 110V or 220V.
